- **Scoring Criteria**: Feasibility of the plan, comprehensiveness, realistic timeline (20 points)

##### 3. **Budget and Resource Allocation**

- Provide a detailed budget for the project. Explain how the funds will be used and justify the expenses.
- **Scoring Criteria**: Budget accuracy, appropriate allocation of resources, cost-effectiveness (20 points)

##### 4. **Community Engagement**

- Describe how you will engage and involve the community in your project. Explain any partnerships or collaborations you plan to leverage.
- **Scoring Criteria**: Community involvement, strength of partnerships, inclusivity (20 points)

##### 5. **Evaluation and Sustainability**

- Explain how you will measure the success of your project. Include any metrics or evaluation methods you will use. Additionally, describe how you plan to sustain the project beyond the grant period.

- **\*Scoring Criteria\***: Clear evaluation plan, sustainability strategy, potential for long-term impact (20 points)

#### #### Rubric for Scoring

Each application will be reviewed and scored by a panel of experts based on the following rubric:

##### 1. **\*\*Project Description (20 points)\*\***

- 0-5 points: Project goals are unclear or poorly defined.
- 6-10 points: Project goals are somewhat clear but lack detail or relevance.
- 11-15 points: Project goals are clear and relevant, with some potential impact.
- 16-20 points: Project goals are very clear, highly relevant, and demonstrate significant potential impact.

##### 2. **\*\*Implementation Plan (20 points)\*\***

- 0-5 points: Plan is vague, unrealistic, or incomplete.
- 6-10 points: Plan is somewhat clear but lacks detail or feasibility.
- 11-15 points: Plan is clear and feasible with most details covered.
- 16-20 points: Plan is comprehensive, highly feasible, and very detailed.

##### 3. **\*\*Budget and Resource Allocation (20 points)\*\***

- 0-5 points: Budget is unclear or inappropriate.
- 6-10 points: Budget is somewhat clear but lacks justification or accuracy.
- 11-15 points: Budget is clear, accurate, and mostly justified.
- 16-20 points: Budget is very clear, highly accurate, and well-justified.

##### 4. **\*\*Community Engagement (20 points)\*\***

- 0-5 points: Community involvement is minimal or absent.
- 6-10 points: Some community involvement but lacks depth or partnerships.
- 11-15 points: Clear community involvement with some strong partnerships.
- 16-20 points: Strong community involvement with excellent partnerships and inclusivity.

##### 5. **\*\*Evaluation and Sustainability (20 points)\*\***

- 0-5 points: Evaluation and sustainability plans are vague or missing.
- 6-10 points: Somewhat clear evaluation plan but lacks sustainability.
- 11-15 points: Clear evaluation plan with some sustainability strategies.
- 16-20 points: Very clear evaluation plan with strong sustainability strategies and potential for long-term impact.
